



FTC Meet Area: The full competition will be held in the school cafeteria. This places the Pits conveniently close to the Playing Field.

<u>Arrival</u>: It is important that all teams <u>arrive on time</u> and <u>report to the check-in table</u> immediately upon arrival. This will allow us to make the match schedule quickly. Please call 862-432-1526 if you are going to be late.

<u>Check In</u>: Team Check-In opens at 4pm. We are looking to our teams to arrive as close to 4pm as possible. We must process teams through inspection and flashing of Samantha in time for a prompt start of matches.

<u>Early Check In</u>: If your team can arrive as early as 3:30, we will admit teams, get them registered, through inspection, flashed to the Meet router, etc. Since we have 16 teams participating, any early start helps us meet our completion schedule.

Opening Ceremony: We will make some remarks at the start of the first Match but there are no Ceremonies, per se, at an Afternoon Meet.

<u>Pit Area</u>: Please stay within the boundaries of your pit and be kind to your neighbors. If you have large banners, displays, or posters, we can find a space somewhere else in the arena for these items. The Pit Areas should stay clear of obstructions to traffic and NO Team networks are allowed in the Pit.

Queuing: Per usual, Event Team Queuers will remind teams (as needed) to come to the Competition Area in time for matches. However, remember that Queuers are there to assist and the BEST teams queue themselves and don't need to be reminded that their match is coming up.



<u>Supplies:</u> Be sure to bring a Utility Strip. Safety Glasses, Battery Chargers (marked with Team Number) and spare parts.

Match Lists: We are often asked "when will Match Lists be available?". They will be handed out ~4:30. The information will be available sooner if all teams are able to pass inspection earlier.

<u>Inspection</u>: Arriving robots report IMMEDIATELY to Inspection. This is always THE pacing element in starting the competition on time. Please help.

<u>Judging:</u> We will have Awards judging taking place during this Meet. We will continue to us the Judging Scorecard and Pit Interview, piloted last season, to expedite the Judging process during these short Meets. No plaques are presented at Afternoon Meets, however there will be Award Certificates. Meet Judging continues to be useful way to convey feedback to teams and prepare them for formal Tournament Judged Interviews. Expect an interview in your Pit area.

Robot Marking: Remember to have your team numbers on the robot in large size, per spec. That sometimes does not happen early in the season. So too, make sure that your robot accommodates the mounting of the Alliance Flag. This has been a problem for some at earlier Meets!

<u>PIZZA for Dinner:</u> W.A*.G.S. will take a food order at Check-In time. We will pause at 6pm so that our volunteers can eat. Similar to last year, the pizza and drink will be very reasonably priced Please bring small bills. Snacks will also be available for purchase.

Individuals are asked to obtain their pizza after the volunteers and to help us to resume matches promptly after 15 minutes (Team members can always eat when not competing. Volunteers need to stay on the job.)

FIRST AID: Please go to the Pit Administration table for basic First Aid Supplies. Please alert the event organizers if more involved care is required.
